10. As of 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025, all horses entering any aged events in ABHA must be registered with an Association that requires proof of DNA for the purpose of age and parenting verification.

11. The ABHA Board reserves the right to question and further investigate the information supplied on the ABHA Age Inspection Forms if any discrepancies arise from the information by the owner or breeder. The ABHA Board of Directors reserves the right to decline any application that can't be verified.

12. Any ABHA member that provides false or misleading information on the ABHA Age Inspection form is subject to the horse's disqualification from aged events and/or disciplinary action.

13. All Age Inspection forms to be filled in by the current owner. The entire form must be completed without alterations. No form will be accepted with whiteout or changed information. The horse markings and vet section to be completed by the Equine Dental Veterinarian.

14. Any current owner/rider of the ABHA that has given false or misleading information regarding the age of the horse, and has proceeded to compete and win prize money or prizes on said horse at any ABHA aged event, will forfeit all prize money and prizes won, which will be required to be returned to the event organiser for redistribution to appropriate placegetters. Failure to do so may result in suspension and refusal of all ABHA event entries until returned.

15. All Aged Horse Registry applications are required to be received by the ABHA Office one week prior to entering an event to allow validating the application.

16. All owners of aged horses who wish to register their horse to compete in any ABHA aged event/s must be a current financial member of the Association. If the owner is not the rider of the horse, the owner/s of the horse are required to be current financial members of the association. Joint owners are both required to be members of the association.

17. Any horse that is entered in an ABHA aged event that does not have an ABHAID number will be disqualified and will forfeit any prizemoney or prizes won.

18. Any affiliate that permits a horse with no ABHAID to compete in an aged event will be issued with a warning and be required to organise the return of prize money and/or prizes won and redistributed to rightful placegetters. After 3 warnings, affiliates may be refused the right to run further aged events.
