<p>Notices of motions</p> <p>Submitted by Shona Tribe and Mary Morgan</p> <p>1/. That the minimum amount of prizemoney posted by a committee to enable them to keep 40% of the entry be raised from the \$100 currently required to \$300</p> <p>Explanation: We feel this is being abused by affiliates who are making money from competitors unnecessarily. The \$100 was a figure introduced years ago as a starting point and we feel this now needs to be raised.</p> <p>2/. That the committee ground levy be abolished and only be applied upon request from a committee to the ABHA board and granted on case by case.</p> <p>Explanation: At the moment a lot of committees are charging a per competitor ground levy and actually making hundreds of dollars from it at each event when the ground hire is very minimal. Nobody has a problem with a committee that has to pay a substantial amount to hire a ground but those that are pocketing hundreds each event we feel is not what the association is about.</p> <p>3/. That a committee cannot keep 40% of the entry fee and charge a ground levy as well.</p> <p>Explanation: Too many committees are money grabbing for their end of year awards and are making hundreds out of competitors at each event. The ABHA is about having somewhere to run your horse that's not expensive.</p> <p>4/. That the ABHA Patsie Holder Memorial Classic become a divisional event. Once entries hit 50 it becomes a 2D and for every 50 after that another division be created.</p> <p>Explanation: There are quite a few horses of classic age that are not entered in this event because it is cheaper to enter the divisional event and the chances of winning more prizes and money are more than double in the divisional event. If the classic becomes at least a</p>	

2D	<p>we believe the entries will increase a lot as there will be a place for those other horses to go.</p> <p>5/. That competitors be able to roll their times from the Classic at the ABHA finals to the divisional event, with their run being made in the Classic event.</p> <p>Explanation: Most affiliates allow this to happen at their events throughout the year. Many young horses aren't up to running four times and therefore competitors have to choose which event they enter. By rolling over times this would cut the number of runs down in the divisional as well which will shorten the divisional day and would again increase the entries in the Classic.</p> <p>6/. That the order of events for the ABHA finals be set and advertised on the entry form</p> <p>Explanation: It is too difficult to organise leave not knowing when you are going to compete and I believe it has become too hard for some members to enter because of this.</p> <p>Notice of Motion submitted by Suzanne Dicks and Kerrie Holder.</p> <p>7/. The red membership and red minute book be presented at each and every AGM for the boards viewing, review and approval. This procedure to be reviewed if desired at each agm to ensure these records are being kept all together.</p> <p>8/. All of the ABHA documentation to be scanned and saved onto a removeable flash drive and to be held by the current President. Records to be saved are to include but not limited to, Secretary's Position Description, All Procedures of the ABHA, Constitution, Rule Book, Red Membership book (in its entirety) Red Minute book (in its entirety). Then each and every year after the financials are audited.</p>
