The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program is awarded from progeny sired by stallions nominated in The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program.

All proceeds collected from the ABHA Stallion Incentive Program and Auction will go towards a side-pot at the 2022 ABHA National Finals for eligible horses entered in the Futurity, Maturity and Open Divisional. The highest placed horse in each event listed will determine the winners of the side-pot.

Payouts will be split equally between the 3 events as follows: 45% stallion owner. 30% rider. 10% ABHA. 15% advertising (inc. stallion advert that can be kept by stallion owner, social media marketing, live feed advertising and a framed stallion advert showcased at the ABHA National Finals.
